Honoring Choices Massachusetts is pleased to offer the internationally recognized Respecting Choices® First Steps Advance Care Planning Facilitator Certification Course in Massachusetts. The course "assists participants in learning effective communication and interview skills for patient-centered Advance Care Planning (ACP) facilitation." Respecting Choices lists their course objectives as follows:

- Identify interview skills for First Steps ACP discussions;
- Identify interview skills for First Steps ACP for adults with chronic illness;
- Describe strategies for creating a clear, thorough, and accurate advance directive document;
- Identify strategies for community engagement;
- Examine three key systems for building an effective ACP program;
- Demonstrate beginning competency in facilitating ACP discussions through role-play activities.

<u>Who Can Attend</u>: Care professionals, nurses, health care staff, social workers, clergy, lay leaders, and *anyone* who engages adults in health care planning discussions. The course is open to Honoring Choices Community Partners and non-Community Partners.

<u>Course Requirements</u>: There are two required components to the First Steps® ACP Facilitator Certification Course:

- 1. A 6 module e-learning prerequisite curriculum that is completed on-line, and
- 2. An 8 hour in-person class instruction and interaction day.

<u>Certification</u>: Upon completion of <u>both</u> the online and on-site components, Respecting Choices will issue the participant a First Steps® ACP Facilitator Certification.

<u>Course Fee:</u> \$600 per person, which includes the Respecting Choices Curriculum Fee (\$110), the 8 hr. on-site class, and the Respecting Choices e-Facilitator Training Manual.

<u>Course Offered:</u> Course is offer in the Spring and Fall.
